They will show us the Yellow-headed Picathartes with their bulky mudcup nests, Kakum National Park with its canopy walkway, Ankasa, a pristine wet-evergreen forest, the superb Mole National Park where they watched African Savanna Elephants from their hotel, the Burkina Faso border with its distinct family of birds, the amazing Egyptian Plover, and the Bobiri Butterfly Sanctuary's primary lowland forest.
